What is the Fuel Surcharge?

The Fuel Surcharge helps account for the changing diesel prices to maintain a high level of service. The Fuel Surcharge applies to all secure logistics services (Cash in Transit, Change Fund, CompuSafe, and ATM) customers and is a percentage of the customer's total invoice (exceptions could apply).

How does it work?

Each month, the fuel surcharge fee will be calculated by multiplying applicable fee(s) for services requiring/involving transportation for the month and the fuel surcharge rate based on your invoice date as set forth in the table above. The U.S. Department of Energy, Energy Information Administration, Retail On-Highway Diesel Fuel Prices reported during all weeks ending in the previous month are averaged to determine the current month's fuel price that is used to index the fuel surcharge rate.
